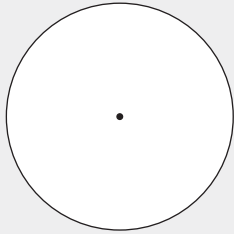


9. Story problems

Story 1: Mother divided a loaf of bread equally between her four children.

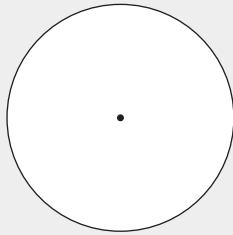


- Is there a fraction corresponding to this story? Explain:

- Draw in the circle a fraction that corresponds to the story.
- What corresponds to the circle in the story?

Story 2: Dalia cut a sheet of bristol paper into 5 equal parts.

She used two of these parts for her end-of-the-year project.



- Are there fractions corresponding to this story? What fractions correspond to it?

- Draw the fractions you suggested in circles.
- What corresponds to the circle in the story?

Discussion

Why does the loaf of bread in story 1 correspond to the circle in the drawing?

Is the bristol paper in story 2 circular? Why does it correspond to the circle in the drawing?

To the teacher:

To help the students find what in each story corresponds to the whole circle, you might ask them what is divided into equal parts. This is the object that corresponds to the whole circle.
